Sometimes there's a clue in the invitation of what to expect...but not this time. A circle with the words "gather 'round". That's probably not even about new phones but is in reference to Apple's new spaceship campus.

So where do you go to find clues? Since iPhones are manufactured in China, I check Alibaba.com, a site similar to Amazon where primarily Chinese companies sell things. I've found hundreds of new phone cases for upcoming phones. These cases are made for 3 devices. A 5.8" iPhone, a 6.5" and a 6" iPhone, believed to be a budget iPhone.

shortly after the announcement went out, 9to5Mac, released this photo of 2 iPhones. The site claims it's an actual photo of the new phones and not the work of an artist and that the new phones will be called the Xs, or 10s.

these photos from 9to5Mac, show the screen is much larger, since Apple is expected to get rid of the home button.

as for what else is different, you can bet the phones will all be faster and have an improved camera.

We also expect two new iPad Pros which possibly would come with no home button...and no headphone jack.
and a new Apple Watch series 4, also with a larger display and better look.

For those who skipped last year's release of the iPhone X, many will be looking to upgrade. This is an important 's' year for Apple. We'll know everything about the new phones, September 12th.

iPhone rumors are usually a highlight of late summer and this year is no exception. Apple sent out invitations for an event September 12th in which we believe Tim Cook will introduce new iPhones, new Apple Watch and new iPad Pros. The challenge is trying to guess what those new devices will be like.

Apple keeps information about new devices secret of course but that doesn't stop tech gurus and publications from making educated guesses about the changes from the previous iterations.

[9to5Mac](#) is usually very good with its reporting of new Apple devices. In previous years its been spot-on with the iPhone 7 and iPhone X. This time around they've released what they've [claimed](#) are actual photos of 2 new iPhones layered on one another. The

publication says there will be 3 new iPhones. One will be similar to the iPhoneX, called the Xs, and two larger phones.

A 6.5" iPhone and a lower-priced 6" model with an LCD screen. According to all reports, the new iPhones will ditch the 'home button' in favor of a larger display and Face ID. Like every other new iPhone that's released, these will be faster than the previous generation with an improved camera.

This YouTube [video](#) claims to be the first video of the new iPhone XS and XS Plus but like all rumors at this part in the game, no one know for sure.

What we do know is we'll have to wait until September 12th and like every other iPhone announcement, it's highly anticipated.
